

ORDER ADOPTING 2014/2015 TAX RATE

§§§ COUNTY OF FLOYD

On motion of Commissioner Nathan Johnson seconded by Commissioner Lindan Morris and passed by the Commissioners' Court of Floyd County, Texas by a vote Four (4) for and One (1) against, for adopting a tax rate for the year 2014/2015, for Floyd County, Texas as follows:

"I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$.0665, and I move to ratify that the amount of property taxes collected be increased by \$ 186,274.00 over last year by the adoption of \$0.665 per \$100.00 valuation with \$251,524.00 tax revenue to be raised from new property added to tax roll for the 2014/2015 budget year."

The 2014/2015 assessed valuation \$398,475,717. The budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by 7.28%, and of that amount \$251,524.00 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year."


There is hereby levied a tax against all real property situated in Floyd County, Texas for the year 2014/2015, at a rate of .665 cents upon each \$100 of assessed valuation of property as rendered to or assessed upon the tax rolls of Floyd County, as of January 1, 2015.

For the collection of county taxes for 2014/2015 the Appraisal District is authorized to allow a discount for early payment of such taxes as follows: *a three percent discount if the taxes are paid in October, 2014; a two percent discount if the taxes are paid in November, 2014; and a one percent discount if the taxes are paid in December, 2014.*
